CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 9-215, C.D.1, C.D. 2, C.D. 3, C.D.4

PUBLIC LAW NO. 9-091

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 9-30, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-39, 9-46, 9-48 and 9-50, by amending sections 1 and 4, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-46 and 9-50, and by further amending section 11, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-39 and 9-48, to appropriate the sum of \$1,436,620 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, as supplemental funding for the operations of the executive branch, Congress and the Public Auditor and for additional contributions; by amending section 1 to transfer to a new line item certain funds previously appropriated therein for elections; by further amending section 5, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-39 and 9-48, to reallocate certain funds previously appropriated for the National Postal Service; by further amending section 16, as amended by Public Law No. 9-46, to modify the lapse date of certain funds; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 9-30 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Operating expenses of the executive branch. The sum of \$14,401,005, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, for the operations of the executive branch of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1996. Of the total funds appropriated under this section, \$743,596 shall be deemed to come from the funds available under sections 216(a)(1) and 216(b) of the Compact of Free Association. accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979; PROVIDED, however, that the allottees for the funds appropriated under subsections (2)(I)(i), (2)(I)(ii) and (2)(I)(iv) of section 11 of this act shall be the Governors of the respective States and the allottee for the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(I)(iii) of section 11 of this act shall be the Director of Public Safety for the State of Chuuk and that all funds appropriated under subsection (2)(I) of section 11 of this act shall not be disbursed from the General Fund to the allottees unless the President certifies that the State involved has entered into a joint law enforcement agreement for the period of October 1, 1995 to September 30, 1996, with the National Government pursuant to chapter 12 of title 12 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that all funds appropriated to Chuuk State under subsection (3) of section 10 of this act shall be retained in the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia until a scholarship recipient is identified to the President or the President's designee, at which time scholarship funds in the amount of the scholarship award shall be disbursed directly to the appropriate educational institution in the form of a two-party check payable to both the scholarship recipient and the educational institution he or she is attending; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottees for the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(o) of section (11) of this act shall be the Chief Justices of the respective States; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottee for the funds appropriated under subsection (1) of section 13 of this act shall be the Director of the Office of Administrative Services. Each allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1996; PROVIDED, however, that the authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by sections 7, 9, 10, 11(2)(s), and 13 shall not lapse, the authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by subsection (1)(e) of section 2 of this act shall lapse as of December 31, 1996, and the authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by subsection (2)(aa) of section 11 and subsection (1)(k) of section 12 of this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1998. It shall be further provided that the authority of the allottee of the funds appropriated by subsection (1)(a)(v) of section 1 of this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1998."
