AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-052, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-071, 9-086 and 9-094, by amending section 4, as amended by Public Law No. 9-086, to modify the use of certain monies appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 9-052, as amended by Public Law No. 9-086, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

> "Section 4. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, for the purpose of funding infrastructure needs, transportation systems, and other economic and social projects, public projects and for other purposes in Yap State. The funds appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as follows:
