## A RESOLUTION

To ratify the "Comprehensive Test-Ban Treaty" that prohibits nuclear weapon tests, and that obliges State Parties to undertake to prevent any nuclear weapon explosion at any place under its jurisdiction or control.

- 1 WHEREAS, the "Comprehensive Nuclear Test Ban Treaty",
- 2 popularly referred to as "CTBT", was adopted by the United Nations
- 3 General Assembly as Resolution 50/245 on September 10, 1996, with
- 4 the unanimous assent of the five permanent members of the United
- 5 Nations Security Council, as well as a recorded plenary vote of
- 6 158 in favor, 3 against, and 5 abstentions; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the CTBT will contribute toward establishing a norm
- 8 of international law against nuclear testing, and represents the
- 9 intention of the international community to end nuclear tests
- 10 universally, and thereby make the world a safer place for
- 11 countless generations; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the CTBT provides that each State Party undertakes
- 13 not to carry out any nuclear weapon test explosion or any other
- 14 nuclear explosion, and to prohibit and prevent any such nuclear
- 15 explosion at any place under its jurisdiction and control; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the CTBT indicates that each State Party undertakes
- 17 to refrain from causing, encouraging, or in any way participating
- 18 in the carrying out of any nuclear weapon test explosion or other
- 19 nuclear explosion; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the CTBT establishes a Comprehensive Nuclear Test
- 21 Ban Organization ("the Organization") to achieve the object and
- 22 purpose of the Treaty, to ensure the implementation of its
- 23 provisions, including those for international verification of
- 24 compliance with it, and to provide a forum for consultation and
- 25 cooperation among State Parties; and

WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia became one of 1 the first signatories of the CTBT on September 24, 1996, during a 2 brief ceremony in the Trusteeship Council Chamber at the United Nations Headquarters in New York; and 4 WHEREAS, the CTBT provides that this Treaty shall be subject 5 to ratification by State Parties according to their respective 6 constitutional processes; and that the treaty's entry into force 7 may be advanced by the prompt ratification by the listed States 8 that are party to the treaty; and 9 WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia has an historic 10 and compelling interest in taking all necessary steps to ensure 11 that nuclear weapons will not be considered for the defense of any 12 13 state, and recognizes that there is fair regional representation on the Organization's Executive Council; and 14 WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia encourages all 15 States, who have not yet expressed their assent to the CTBT, to 16 reconsider the moral, ethical, and legal imperatives favoring 17 their adoption of the CTBT, and to join immediately other peaceful 18 nations by acceding to the CTBT to build an unequivocal global 19 20 consensus; now, therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the Ninth Congress of the Federated States 21 of Micronesia, Fifth Special Session, 1997, that pursuant to 22 section 2(b) of article IX of the Constitution of the Federated 23 States of Micronesia, the Congress hereby ratifies the 24 Comprehensive Test Ban Treaty, the CTBT; and 25
