
A RESOLUTION

Conveying sincere condolences to the people of the State of Israel, and in particular to the family of the late Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin, and expressing the deep sorrow and profound sense of loss felt by the Members of the Ninth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia upon learning of the tragic and untimely loss to the world of this great statesman and peacemaker.

1 WHEREAS, His Excellency the Prime Minister of Israel, the
2 Honorable Yitzhak Rabin, was tragically slain by an assassin's
3 bullet on Saturday, November 4th, 1995; and

4 WHEREAS, Prime Minister Rabin had, prior to his untimely
5 passing, dedicated his life to his country, as a leader of world
6 stature, first in war and, most recently, in peace; and

7 WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia and Israel have,
8 since the two countries established diplomatic ties, enjoyed a
9 cordial, friendly and mutually supportive relationship; and

10 WHEREAS, the Members of the Ninth Congress are deeply
11 saddened by the untimely passing and loss of this great man; now,
12 therefore,

13 BE IT RESOLVED by the Ninth Congress of the Federated States
14 of Micronesia, Second Regular Session, 1995, that the Members of
15 the Ninth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia hereby
16 convey, on behalf of the people of the Federated States of
17 Micronesia, sincere condolences to the people of the State of
18 Israel, and in particular to the family of the late Prime Minister
19 Yitzhak Rabin, and express the deep sorrow and profound sense of
20 loss felt by the Members upon learning of the tragic and untimely
21 loss to the world of this great statesman and peacemaker; and


