Dear Speaker Simina:

I am pleased to transmit the following Act, which I signed into Public Law No. 20-103:

Congressional Act No. 20-100, entitled: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 1, 3, 8 AND 9 OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 20-42, A AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 20-54, 20-64, 20-67, 20-83 AND 20-94, IN ORDER TO APPROPRIATE \$655,000 OF ADDITIONAL FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2018, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

I noted that Congress refused to provide funding to key activities and projects, in particular, for PATS and Fiber Optic Cable Landing Station in Chuuk. I urge Congress to reconsider its position on these important and urgent projects.

I thank you and all members of Congress for the expeditious action on the supplemental budget.

AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 3, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-64, 20-67, 20-83 and 20-94, in order to appropriate \$655,000 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
