
Dear Speaker Simina:

Congressional Act No. 20-120, "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 1, 3, 8 AND 9 OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 20-42, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 20-54, 20-64, 20-67, 20-83, 20-94 AND 20-103, IN ORDER TO APPROPRIATE \$73,140,000 OF ADDITIONAL FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2018, TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE OPERATIONS OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA, VARIOUS GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS AND CAPITAL AND HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT, INCLUDING ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE FSM TRUST FUND, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

FIFTH REGULAR SESSION, 2018

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 20-230, C.D.1,
C.D.2, C.D.3

AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 3, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-64, 20-67, 20-83, 20-94 and 20-103, in order to appropriate \$73,140,000 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, to provide funding for the operations of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, various grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development, including additional funding for the FSM Trust Fund, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-67, 20-83, 20-94 and 20-103, is hereby
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to
5 appropriate the sum of \$167,199,022 from the General
6 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
7 fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, for the purpose
8 of funding the operations of all branches of the
9 National Government of the Federated States of
10 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants,
11 subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human
12 Resources Development. The National Government's share
13 of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero;
14 EXCEPT THAT; the National Government will retain 10
15 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is
16 reflected in the budget for the Department of Education.

1 The sum appropriated herein shall be apportioned as
2 follows:"

3 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by
4 Public Law Nos. 20-67, 20-83 and 20-94 is hereby further amended
5 to read as follows:

6 Section 3. Operating Expenses of the Legislative
7 Branch. The sum of \$7,055,285, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
9 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
10 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, for the
11 operations of the Legislative Branch of the National
12 Government during fiscal year 2018. The sum appropriated
13 by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

14 (1) Speaker and Members.

15 The sum of 3,384,498, or so much thereof as may be
16 necessary, for the operations of the Office of the
17 Speaker and Members of the Congress of the Federated
18 States of Micronesia during fiscal year 2018. The sum
19 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:
