Dear Speaker Simina:

I am pleased to transmit the following Act, which I have signed as Public Law No. 20-154, with item veto:

Congressional Act No. 20-151, entitled: "AN ACT AMEND SECTIONS 1, 2, 8 AND 9 OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 20-131, TO APPROPRIATE \$3,752,343 OF ADDITIONAL FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2019, TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE **OPERATIONS** OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA, **VARIOUS** GRANTS. SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS AND CAPITAL AND HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Contained in the Act under Capital and Human Resources Development is a budget line item of \$1.7M for land acquisition in Guam. I have vetoed this item. We are grateful for the other executive branch funding contained within the Act; however, we had anticipated that we would be able to submit other supplemental funding requests for your consideration.

Accordingly, I am transmitting a Supplemental Budget request in the amount of \$1.7M to address other priority funding requirements of the executive branch, and ask for your favorable consideration during this session. Our plan for land acquisition in Guam remains a priority for our National Government, and I intend to re-submit a request for this funding in the very near future. I look forward to your continued support for this initiative.

I have also line item vetoed the project entitled "COM-FSM Building Infrastructure Project" in the amount of \$615,000. This amount has been previously appropriated in section 9 of P.L. 19-118.

Additionally, there is a required correction that needs to be made on page 3, line 25: Department of R&D travel budget. The correct amount is \$286,791. Thank you.

#### AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3, 8, and 9 of Public Law No. 20-131, to appropriate \$3,752,343 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, to provide funding for the operations of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-131 is hereby

The purpose of this act is to "Section 1.
