CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 20-62, C.D.1, C.D.2, C.D.3

AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160 and 20-14, in order to appropriate \$9,011,700 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2017, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
