

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 20-62, C.D.1,
C.D.2, C.D.3

AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160 and 20-14, in order to appropriate \$9,011,700 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2017, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160, is
3 hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. Title. The title of this act is as
5 follows: To appropriate the sum of \$84,137,210 from
6 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia
7 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, for the
8 purpose of funding the operations of all branches of
9 the National Government of the Federated States of
10 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants,
11 subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human
12 Resources Development. The National Government's
13 share of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to
14 zero; EXCEPT THAT, the National Government will retain
15 10 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant funds
16 as is reflected in the budget for the Department of
17 Education. The sum appropriated herein shall be
18 apportioned as follows:"

1 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160, 20-01 and
3 20-14, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 2. Operating Expenses of the Executive Branch.
5 The sum of \$18,706,317 or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
7 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
8 year ending September 30, 2017, for the purpose of
9 funding the operations of the Executive Branch of the
10 National Government during the fiscal year 2017. The
11 sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as
12 follows:
