I am pleased to transmit the following Congressional Act, which I have signed into Public Law No. 20-117:

Congressional Act No. 20-113, entitled: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-117, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 18-120, 19-04, 19-08, 19-35, 19-49, 19-59, 19-76, 19-102 and 20-26 BY AMENDING SECTION 6 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE LAPSE DATE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN, FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS FOR THE PEOPLE OF THE STATES OF YAP, KOSRAE, POHNPEI AND CHUUK, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

This act is extending the lapse date to September 30, 2019, of certain funds for public projects and social programs for the four FSM States appropriated by Congress in 2015.

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-117, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-120, 19-04, 19-08, 19-35, 19-49, 19-59, 19-76, 19-102 and 20-26 by amending section 6 thereof, to change the lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of the states of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-117, as amended
- 2 by Public Law 19-04, 19-59, 19-102 and 20-26 is hereby further
- 3 amended to read as follows:

4	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
5	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
6	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
7	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
8	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
9	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
10	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
11	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
12	no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
13	appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
14	under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
15	State; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated
16	under subsection 2(i) shall be the President of COM-FSM.
17	The allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and

4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3(a)(b)(c)(d)(e)(f)(g)(h)(i)(j)(k)(l) and (m) shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government; the allotte of funds appropriation under sections 4(3)(a) and 4(3)(f) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(3)(h) of this act shall be the Meninkeden Lapalap of Madolenimw and the allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(3)(i) of this act shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of section 5 of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of section 5 of this act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of section 5 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of section 5 of this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act to the states of Yap, Chuuk, Kosrae and Pohnpei shall lapse on September 30, 2019." TUBLIC LAW No. 2 0- 117
