
Dear Speaker Simina:

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140, 19-150 and 20-05, by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to correct technical errors and omissions by changing the use and lapse date of some funds previously appropriated therein, to fund priority infrastructure projects and other programs in the states of Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4. Section 4 of Public Law No. 19-124,

23 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-124, as  
 24 amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140 and 20-05, is hereby  
 25 further amended to read as follows:




1 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
2 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
3 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
4 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
5 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
6 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
7 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
8 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that  
9 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
10 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
11 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of the  
12 State of Yap or his designee. The allottee of the funds  
13 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be  
14 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or  
15 his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds  
16 appropriated under subsections 3(1)(a) and 3(1)(b) of  
17 this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his  
18 designee, the allottee of funds appropriated under  
19 subsections 4(1)(c) through 4(1)(o), 4(2)(f), 4(4)(b),  
20 4(4)(d), 4(4)(f), shall be the Pohnpei Transportation  
21 Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated  
22 under subsections 4(1)(a), 4(1)(b), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d),  
23 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i), 4(2)(j) and sections  
24 4(3)(a) to 4(3)(v) shall be the Secretary of the  
25 Department of Transportation, Communications and

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Infrastructure or his designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under section 5 of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2019.

Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
