

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by Public Law No. 18-106, by amending sections 4 and 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the States of Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 18-99 is hereby amended  
2 to read as follow:
