

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate \$44,621,010 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Title. The title of this act is as follows: To
2 appropriate the sum of \$44,621,010 from the General Fund of the
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
4 September 30, 2014, for the purpose of funding the operations of
5 all branches of the National Government of the Federated States
6 of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies
7 and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development.
8 Of the total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$2,400,000
9 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the Amended
10 Compact from the education sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come
11 from funds available under the Amended Compact from the health
12 sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under
13 the Amended Compact from the infrastructure sector; \$-0- shall be
14 deemed to come from funds available under the Amended Compact
15 from the public sector capacity building; \$-0- shall be deemed to
16 come from funds available under the Amended Compact from the
17 enhanced reporting and accountability sector; and \$-0- shall be
18 deemed to come from funds available under the Supplemental

1 Education Grant. The sum appropriated herein shall be
2 apportioned as follows:

3 Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch. The
4 sum of \$16,816,463, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
5 hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States
6 of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, for
7 the purpose of funding the operations of the Executive Branch of
8 the National Government during the fiscal year 2014. Of the total
9 amount of funds appropriated herein, \$-0- shall be deemed to come
10 from funds available under the Amended Compact from the education
11 sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under
12 the Amended Compact from the health sector; \$-0- shall be deemed
13 to come from funds available under the Amended Compact from the
14 infrastructure sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds
15 available under the Amended Compact from the enhanced reporting
16 and accountability sector; and \$-0- shall be deemed to come from
17 funds available under the Supplemental Education Grant. The sum
18 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

13 Section 11. Reprogramming. Reprogramming of funds into or
14 from the personnel budget line item shall not be permitted. The
15 President, Speaker, Chief Justice and Public Auditor may
16 reprogram up to 10% percent to or from the funds appropriated in
17 sections 2 (Operating expenses of the Executive Branch), 3
18 (Operating expenses of the Legislative Branch), 4 (Operating
19 expenses of the National Judicial Branch), and 5 (Operating
20 expenses of the National Public Auditor). Reprogramming of
21 funds within a department, office or agency shall be effected by
22 the head of such department, office or agency by specifying in
23 writing to the Secretary of the Department of Finance and
24 Administration of the FSM National Government, the accounts for
25 which funding is either increased or decreased. Reprogramming

1 other than as specified herein is not permitted, and more
2 specifically, reprogramming into or out of any line item
3 contained in section 8 (Grants, Subsidies and Contributions) or
4 section 9 (Investment: Capital and Human Resources) is not
5 permitted. The President shall report to Congress within one
6 month of the last day of each financial quarter all amounts
7 reprogrammed inter or intra a department, office or agency.

8 Section 13. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
9 dates.

10 (1) General provisions.

11 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
12 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance
13 with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the
14 Financial Management Act of 1979.

15 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring
16 that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are
17 used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no
18 obligations are incurred in excess of the sums appropriated.

19 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds appropriated
20 by this act are as follows:

21 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall be
22 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

23 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall be
24 the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of
25 Micronesia;

1 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall be
2 the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated States of
3 Micronesia;

4 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall be
5 the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia;

6 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these
7 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
8 Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following subsections
9 of sections 8 through 9 of this act:

10 (i) Section 8(6)(g) - the allottee shall be the
11 President of the College of Micronesia - FSM; and

12 (ii) Section 8, (13)(a) through (d) - the
13 allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the
14 respective State Supreme Court;

15 (iii) Section 8 (10)(a) through (d) - the
16 allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of
17 the Federated States of Micronesia; and

18 (iv) Section 9(1)(a) through (c) - the allottee
19 of these funds shall be the President of the College of
20 Micronesia-FSM.

21 (3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to
22 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of
23 September 30, 2014; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds
24 appropriated under section 9 of this act shall not lapse.

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1 Section 14. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
