
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140 and 19-150, by amending the title and sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 6 thereof, to modify the intent of the appropriation act and change the use, allottee and lapse date of some funds previously appropriated therein to fund priority infrastructure projects in the state of Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The title of Public Law No. 19-124 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 “To appropriated the sum of \$~~[12,000,000]~~ 11,300,000 from the
4 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
5 year ending September 30, 2017, for the purpose of funding
6 priority infrastructure projects and other programs in all of the
7 four states, and for other purposes.

8 Section 2. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by
9 Public Law No. 19-140, is hereby further amended to read as
10 follows:

11 “Section 1. The sum of \$11,300,000, or so much thereof
12 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
13 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
14 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, for the
15 purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and
16 other programs in all of the four states. The funds
17 appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as

1 follows:

2 Section 3. Section 2 of Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by
3 Public Law No. 19-140, is hereby further amended to read as
4 follows:

5 "Section 2. Of the \$11,300,000 appropriated under this
6 act, \$1,750,000 shall be apportioned for priority
7 infrastructure projects and other programs in the state
8 of Yap.

 5 infrastructure projects and other programs in the state
 6 of Kosrae.

1 Section 5. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-124, as
2 amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-133 and 19-140, is hereby further
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
5 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
6 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
7 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
8 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
9 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
10 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
11 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
12 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
13 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
14 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of the
15 State of Yap or his designee. The allottee of the funds
16 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be
17 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
18 his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
19 appropriated under subsections 3(1)(a) and 3(1)(b) of
20 this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his
21 designee, the allottee of funds appropriated under
22 subsections 4(1)(c) through 4(1)(o), 4(2)(f), 4(3)(c),
23 4(3)(d), 4(3)(e), 4(3)(g), 4(3)(k) and 4(3)(q), 4(3)(s),
24 4(4)(b), 4(4)(d), 4(4)(f), shall be the Pohnpei
25 Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds
