

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36, 21-53 and 21-56, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36, 21-53 and 21-56, is hereby  
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4. Of the \$9,800,000 appropriated under this  
5 act, \$2,800,000 shall be apportioned for public projects  
6 and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State.

15           Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended  
16 by Public Laws Nos. 21-01 and 21-36, 21-53 and 21-56, is hereby  
17 amended to read as follows:

18           "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
19 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
20 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
21 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
22 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
23 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
24 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
25 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that

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1 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
2 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
3 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap  
4 State or his designee. The allottee of funds  
5 appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the  
6 Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT  
7 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
8 3(ad) of this act and 4(2)(q) shall be the President of  
9 COM-FSM or his designee; the allottee of funds  
10 appropriated under subsections 3(ae) to 3(ak) of this  
11 act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his  
12 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
13 subsection 3(al) of this act shall be the Secretary of  
14 the FSM Department of Education or his designee. The  
15 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this  
16 act shall be the President of the Federated States of  
17 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee  
18 of funds appropriated under section 4(1) and subsection  
19 4(3)(w) of this act shall be the Vice President of the  
20 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; allottee  
21 of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(v) of this  
22 act shall be the Mayor of Kolonia Town Government or his  
23 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
24 subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(c) of this act  
25 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health and

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1 Social Affairs or her designee; the allottee of funds  
2 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(d), 4(3)(y) and  
3 4(3)(z) of this act shall be the Secretary of the  
4 Department of Education or his designee; the allottee of  
5 funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(u), 4(4)(f)  
6 and 4(3)(p) of this act shall be the Pohnpei  
7 Transportation Authority, the funds appropriated under  
8 subsection 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the President of  
9 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, the  
10 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(x)  
11 of this act shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of  
12 Madolenihmw Municipal Government or his designee; the  
13 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(i) and 4(3)(j)  
14 of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of  
15 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his  
16 designee; The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
17 subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this act shall be the  
18 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of  
19 the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act  
20 shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority  
21 (MIDA); the allottee of the funds appropriated under  
22 subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern  
23 Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the  
24 funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act  
25 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The



1            authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated  
2            by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2020.”

3            Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
4 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
5 becoming law without such approval.
