

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 21-157, by amending section 5 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 21-157 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 5. Of the \$2,100,000 appropriated under this
4 act, \$900,000 shall be apportioned to fund public
5 projects and social programs for the people of Chuuk
6 State.
