

A RESOLUTION

Approving and accepting a grant from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), in the amount of \$662,313, to fund and support the FSM Department of Health and Social Affairs and its Behavioral Health and Wellness Program (BHWP) in carrying out their Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment (SAPT) services, including all the terms and conditions of the assistance.

1 WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, the United States Department of
2 Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health
3 Services Administration (SAMHSA), issued a Notice of Grant Award
4 in the amount of \$662,313, to fund and support the FSM Department
5 of Health and Social Affairs and its Behavioral Health and
6 Wellness Program (PHWP) in carrying out their Substance Abuse
7 Prevention and Treatment (SAPT) services; and

8 WHEREAS, the purpose of this grant is to provide COVID-19
9 emergency relief funding to support the FSM and its Department of
10 Health and Social Affairs by funding substance abuse prevention
11 and treatment services provided to the people of the FSM; and

12 WHEREAS, the project period and budget period for this grant
13 is March 15, 2021 to March 14, 2023; and

14 WHEREAS, this is a foreign finance assistance as defined
15 under section 210(1)(b) of title 55 of the Code of the Federated
16 States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, and

17 WHEREAS, section 210((2) of title 55 of the Code of the
18 Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, requires
19 that for foreign financial assistance to be valid it must be

1 approved by Congress by resolution; now, therefore,

2 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-First Congress of the Federated
3 States of Micronesia, Tenth Special Session, 2021, that Congress
4 hereby approves and accepts the \$662,313 grant from the U.S.
5 Department of health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and
6 Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), to fund and
7 support the FSM in its Behavioral Health and Wellness Program
8 (BHWP) in implementing their Substance Abuse Prevention and
9 Treatment (SAPT) services, including all the terms and conditions
10 thereof; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
12 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
13 of Micronesia, the Secretary of the Department of Health and
14 Social Affairs, the Secretary of the Department of Finance and
15 Administration, the Secretary of the Department of Foreign Affairs
16 and the Secretary of the Department of Justice.
