

A RESOLUTION

Approving and accepting a grant in the amount of \$372,499 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, Center for Substance Abuse Treatment, to provide funding to the FSM Behavioral Health and Wellness Program and its related activities and services, including all the terms and conditions of the assistance.

1           WHEREAS, on July 12, 2022 , the U.S. Department of Health  
2 and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services  
3 Administration, Center for Substance Abuse Treatment, issued a  
4 Notice of Award in the amount of \$372,499, to the FSM Department  
5 of Health and Social Affairs; and

6           WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is to provide funding for  
7 substance abuse prevention and treatment services to the people  
8 of the FSM with substance abuse related problems; and

9           WHEREAS, section 219(2) of title 55 of the Code of the  
10 Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, provides  
11 that for foreign financial assistance to be valid it must be  
12 approved by Congress by resolution; now, therefore,

13           BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Second Congress of the  
14 Federated States of Micronesia, Fifth Regular Session, 2022,  
15 that Congress hereby approved and accepts the \$372,499 grant  
16 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Substance  
17 Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, Center for  
18 Substance Abuse Treatment, to provide funding to the FSM

1 Department of Health and Social Affairs, Behavioral Health and  
2 Wellness Program for prevention and treatment services related  
3 to substance abuse, including all the terms and conditions  
4 thereof; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
6 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated  
7 States of Micronesia, the Secretary of the Department of Health  
8 and Social Affairs, the Secretary of the Department of Justice,  
9 the Secretary of the Department of Foreign Affairs, and the U.S.  
10 Embassy in Kolonia.
