

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-141, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-145, 20-163, 20-164, 20-190, 21-05, 21-33, 21-48, 21-67, 21-91, 21-182, 21-193, 22-34, 22-69, 22-77, 22-160, 22-177, 23-04, 23-20 and 23-27, by amending sections 3 and 6 thereof, to change the use and extend the lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other projects and programs in the states of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 20-141, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 20-145, 20-163, 20-164, 21-33, 21-48, 21-67,
3 22-69, 22-77, 22-160, 22-177 and 23-04, is hereby further
4 amended to read as follows:

5 "Section 3. Of the \$12,800,000 appropriated under this
6 act, \$2,000,000 shall be apportioned for priority
7 infrastructure projects and other projects and programs
8 in the state of Kosrae.

14 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-141, as amended
 15 by Public Laws Nos. 20-163, 20-164, 20-190, 21-05, 21-33, 21-48,
 16 21-91, 21-193, 22-34, 23-20 and 23-27, is hereby further amended
 17 to read as follows:

18 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
 19 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
 20 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 21 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
 22 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
 23 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
 24 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
 25 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that

1 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
2 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
3 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of
4 Yap State or his designee PROVIDED THAT the allottee of
5 funds appropriated under subsections 2(a) and 2(b) of
6 this act shall be the President of the Federated States
7 of Micronesia or his designee; the allottee of funds
8 appropriated under subsection 2(k) of this act shall be
9 the Yap State Public Service Corporation (YSPSC). The
10 allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 3 and
11 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated
12 States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT,
13 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
14 3(a), 3(b), 3(c), 3(e), 3(f), 3(g), 3(h), 3(j), 3(k),
15 3(l), 3(m), 3(n), 3(o), 3(p), 3(q), 3(s), 3(t), 3(u),
16 3(v), 3(w), 3(x), 3(y), 3(z), 3(a3) to 3(a10), 3(a30)
17 and 3(a31) of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town
18 Government or his designee; the allottee of funds
19 appropriated under subsections 3(d), 3(i), 3(r), 3(a2)
20 and 3(a11) to 3(a25) of this act shall be the Mayor of
21 Tafunsak Municipal Government or his designee; the
22 allottee the allottee of funds appropriated under
23 subsections (a27), (a28) and (a29) of this act shall be
24 the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the
25 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(a26)

1 is the Secretary of the FSM Department of Education or
2 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
3 section 4(1) of this act shall be the Secretary of the
4 Department of Transportation, Communications and
5 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
6 appropriated under subsections 4(2) (a) to 4(2) (s),
7 4(2) (ab), 4(3) (a), 4(3) (b), 4(3) (c), 4(3) (d), 4(3) (k),
8 4(3) (x), 4(4) (a), 4(4) (b), 4(4) (c), 4(4) (d), 4(4) (g),
9 4(4) (h), 4(4) (i), 4(4) (j) and 4(4) (k) of this act shall
10 be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA) except
11 that the allottee of funds appropriated under
12 subsection 4(2) (l) of this act shall be the
13 Administrator of MiCare program or her designee; the
14 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3) (n)
15 of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
16 Health and Social Affairs or her designee, the allottee
17 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2) (h),
18 4(2) (q), 4(2) (u), 4(2) (ac), 4(2) (v), 4(2) (w), 4(2) (x),
19 4(2) (z) and 4(3) (r) of this act shall be the Secretary
20 of the Department of Transportation, Communications and
21 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
22 appropriated under subsection 4(2) (y) of this act shall
23 be the Pohnpei Port Authority; the allottee of funds
24 appropriated under subsection 4(2) (aa) of this act
25 shall be the Chief Magistrate of Sokehs Municipal

1 Government or his designee; the allottee of fund
2 appropriated under subsection and 4(4) (l) of this act
3 shall be the Mayor of Pingelap Municipal Government;
4 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection and
5 4(4) (m) of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of
6 Mwoakilloa Municipal Government; the allottee of funds
7 appropriated under subsections 4(3) (e), 4(3) (f),
8 4(3) (j), 4(3) (p), 4(3) (w) and 4(3) (z) of this act shall
9 be the Menin Keder Lapalap of Madolenihmw; the allottee
10 of funds appropriated 4(3) (a5) shall be the Secretary
11 of the Department of Health and Social Affairs. The
12 allottee of the funds appropriated sections 5 of this
13 act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
14 designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
15 appropriated under subsections 5(g) and 5(j) of this
16 act shall be the FSM Telecommunication Corporation or
17 its designee and the allottee of funds appropriated
18 under subsections 5(d) and 5(e) of this act shall be
19 the FSM Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
20 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee. The
21 authority of the allottee to obligate funds
22 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,
23 2026.”

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Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
