

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140, 19-150, 20-05, 20-15, 20-33, 20-48, 20-63, 20-71, 20-156, 20-175, 21-22, 21-52, 21-146, 21-156, 21-195, 21-213, 21-244, 22-25, 22-62, 22-111, 23-38 and 23-55, by amending sections 2, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use, allottee and lapse date of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund priority infrastructure projects and other programs for Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 19-124, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 19-140, 20-05, 21-244 and 23-55, is hereby
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 2. Of the \$11,300,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$1,750,000 shall be apportioned for priority
6 infrastructure projects in the state of Yap.

9 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by
 10 Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140, 20-05, 20-15, 20-33, 20-48,
 11 20-63, 20-156, 21-22, 21-146, 21-195, 21-244, 22-111 and 23-55,
 12 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

13 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
 14 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
 15 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 16 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
 17 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
 18 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
 19 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
 20 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
 21 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
 22 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
 23 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of
 24 the State of Yap or his designee. The allottee of the
 25 funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act

1 shall be the President of the Federated States of
2 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee
3 of funds appropriated under subsections 3(1)(a) and
4 3(1)(b) of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae
5 State or his designee, the allottee of funds
6 appropriated under subsections 4(1)(c), 4(1)(d),
7 4(1)(e), 4(1)(g), 4(1)(h), 4(1)(i), 4(1)(j), 4(1)(k),
8 4(1)(l), 4(1)(m), 4(1)(n), 4(1)(o), 4(2)(f), 4(3)(k),
9 4(3)(q), 4(3)(s), 4(3)(af), 4(4)(b), 4(4)(d) and
10 4(4)(f), shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority
11 (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
12 subsections 4(1)(a), 4(1)(b), 4(1)(f), 4(1)(p),
13 4(1)(q), 4(1)(r), 4(1)(s), 4(1)(t), 4(1)(u), 4(1)(v),
14 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i),
15 4(2)(j), 4(3)(x), and 4(3)(o) shall be the Secretary of
16 the Department of Transportation, Communications and
17 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
18 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(f), 4(3)(i),
19 4(3)(w) and 4(3)(aa) of this act shall be the Luhk en
20 Moanlap of Kitti, the allottee of funds appropriated
21 under subsection 4(3)(ad) of this act shall be the
22 Chief Justice of Madolenihmw or his designee, the
23 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
24 4(3)(ae) of this act shall be the Chief Justice of
25 Kitti or his designee; the allottee of funds

1 appropriated under subsection 4(3)(an) of this act
2 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health and
3 Social Affairs or his designee. The allottee of the
4 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(ak) and
5 4(3)(ao) of this act shall be the Vice President of the
6 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the
7 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
8 4(3)(al) and 4(3)(ap) of this act shall be the
9 Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw Municipal Government
10 or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated
11 under sections 5(2) and 5(7) of this act shall be the
12 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee
13 of funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)(3) of this
14 act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority
15 (MIDA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
16 subsections 5(1)(1) and 5(1)(4) of this act shall be
17 the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee;
18 EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
19 subsection 5(1)(m) of this act shall be the FSM
20 Telecommunication Corporation; the allottee of funds
21 appropriated under subsection 5(1)(5) of this act shall
22 be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority (SNDA);
23 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
24 5(1)(6) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
25 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate

1 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
2 30, 2026.”

3 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
4 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
5 becoming law without such approval.
