

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-125, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-135, 20-146, 20-157, 20-179, 20-189, 21-06, 21-40, 21-59, 21-96, 21-141, 21-155, 21-217, 21-225, 21-230, 21-239, 22-20, 22-70, 22-88, 22-95, 22-144, 22-201 and 23-51, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and lapse date of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the states of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 20-125, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 20-135, 20-146, 20-179, 20-189, 21-06, 21-59,
3 21-89 and 21-155, is hereby further amended to ready as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the \$7,000,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$3,000,000 shall be apportioned for public projects
6 and social programs for the people of Chuuk State.

5 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-125, as amended by
 6 Public Laws Nos. 20-135, 20-157, 20-179, 21-40, 21-89, 21-141,
 7 21-155, 21-230, 21-239, 22-70, 22-88 and 22-144, is hereby
 8 further amended to read as follows:

9 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 10 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 11 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 12 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
 13 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
 14 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
 15 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
 16 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
 17 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
 18 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
 19 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
 20 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
 21 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be
 22 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
 23 his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
 24 appropriated under subsections 3(a) to 3(q) of this act
 25 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his

1 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
2 subsection 3(t) of this act shall be the Governor of
3 Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee of funds
4 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(g) of this act shall
5 be the Mayor of Nukuoro Municipal Government or his
6 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
7 subsection 4(2)(j) of this act shall be the President of
8 the COM-FSM College or his designee; the allottee of
9 funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(p) and 4(1)(w)
10 of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation;
11 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
12 4(2)(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (h), (i), (k), (l),
13 (m), (n), (o), (q), (r), (s) and (v) of this act shall
14 be the Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
15 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee. The
16 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
17 4(4)(j) of this act shall be the Mayor of Pingelap
18 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
19 funds appropriated under subsection 4(4)(k) of this act
20 shall be the Mayor of Mwokilloa Municipal Government or
21 his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
22 subsection 4(4)(m) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
23 Transportation Authority. The allottee of the funds
24 appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act
25 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee;

1 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
2 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island
3 Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the funds
4 appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act shall be
5 the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee;
6 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
7 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas
8 Development Authority; the allottee of the funds
9 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be
10 the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the
11 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act
12 shall lapse on September 30, 2026.”

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1 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
