

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-102, 21-115, 21-137, 21-165, 21-178, 21-200 and 21-218, by amending sections 3, 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Kosrae and Pohnpei States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-53, 21,56, 21-90, 21-137 and
3 21-178, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 3. Of the \$9,800,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$1,400,000 shall be apportioned for public
6 projects and social programs for the people of Kosrae
7 State.

21 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 21-178, as amended
22 by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-102, 21-137.
23 21-165 and 21-218, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

24 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
25 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be

1 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
2 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
3 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
4 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
5 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
6 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
7 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
8 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
9 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
10 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
11 appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the
12 Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT
13 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
14 3(ad) of this act and 4(2)(q) shall be the President of
15 COM-FSM or his designee; the allottee of funds
16 appropriated under subsections 3(ae) to 3(ao) of this
17 act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
18 designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds
19 appropriated under subsection 3(al) of this act shall be
20 the Secretary of the FSM Department of Education or his
21 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
22 section 4 of this act shall be the President of the
23 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED
24 THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
25 4(2)(c) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation

1 Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under
2 section 4(1) and subsection 4(3)(w) of this act shall be
3 the Vice President of the Federated States of Micronesia
4 or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated
5 under subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(c) of this
6 act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health
7 and Social Affairs or her designee; the allottee of
8 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(d), 4(3)(y)
9 and 4(3)(z) of this act shall be the Secretary of the
10 Department of Education or his designee; the allottee of
11 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(ab), 4(4)(f)
12 and 4(3)(p) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
13 Transportation Authority, the funds appropriated under
14 subsection 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the President of
15 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, the
16 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(x)
17 of this act shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of
18 Madolenihmw Municipal Government or his designee; the
19 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(i), 4(3)(j) of
20 this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
21 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his
22 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
23 subsection 4(3)(ae) of this act shall be the Secretary
24 of the Department of Resources and Development or his
25 designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under

1 subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the
2 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of
3 the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act
4 shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority
5 (MIDA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
6 subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno
7 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
8 the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act
9 shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority;
10 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
11 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
12 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
13 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
14 30, 2022.”
