

AN ACT

To further amend sections 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 21-185, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-210, 21-221, 21-238, 22-01, 22-30, 22-41 and 22-137, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 21-185, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 21-210, 21-221 21-238, 22-01, 22-30, 22-41, and  
3 22-137, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4           "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.

5           The sum of \$16,473,088 or so much thereof as may be  
6           necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
7           of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
8           year ending September 30, 2021, for the following  
9           capital improvements, development programs, and projects  
10          and human resources development. Of the total amount of  
11          funds appropriated herein, \$1,246,022 shall be deemed to  
12          come from funds available under the Supplemental  
13          Education Grant and \$1,000,000 shall be deemed to come  
14          from funds available under the Compact Sector Grants.  
15          The sum appropriated by this section shall be  
16          apportioned as follows:

16 Section 2. Section 12 of Public Law No. 21-185, as amended  
17 by Public Laws Nos. 21-210, 21-221, 21-238, 22-01, 22-41, and 22-  
18 137, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

19 "Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and  
20 Lapse Dates.

21 (1) General provisions.

22 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
23 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
24 accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
25 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

1                   (b) The allottees shall be responsible for  
2                   ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be  
3                   necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in  
4                   this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess  
5                   of the sums appropriated.

6                   (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds  
7                   appropriated by this act are as follows:

8                   (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds  
9                   shall be the President of the Federated States of  
10                  Micronesia;

11                  (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds  
12                  shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated  
13                  States of Micronesia;

14                  (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds  
15                  shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the  
16                  Federated States of Micronesia;

17                  (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds  
18                  shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of  
19                  Micronesia;

20                  (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these  
21                  funds shall be the President of the Federated States of  
22                  Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following  
23                  subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:

24                  (i) Sections 8(1)(f) and 8(13)(q) - the  
25                  allottee of these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint

1 Committee on Compact Review and Planning;

2 (ii) Section 8(8)(a) – the allottee of these  
3 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;

4 (iii) Section 8(8)(b) – the allottee of these  
5 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;

6 (iv) Section 8(8)(c) – the allottee of these  
7 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

8 (v) Section 8(8)(d) – the allottee of these  
9 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;

10 (vi) Section 8(11) – the allottee of these  
11 funds shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated  
12 States of Micronesia;

13 (vii) Sections 8(12) and 9(11)(v) – the  
14 allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker of the  
15 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia;

16 (viii) Section 8(13)(a) – the allottee of  
17 these funds shall be the President of the College of  
18 Micronesia-FSM;

19 (ix) Section 8(13)(d) through (g) – the  
20 allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of  
21 the respective State Supreme Court;

22 (x) Section 8(13)(h) – the allottee of  
23 these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme  
24 Court of the Federated States of Micronesia;

25 (xi) Section 8(13)(t) – the allottee of

1           these funds shall be the National Olympic Committee;

2                       (xii) Section 8(13)(u) - the allottee of  
3           these funds shall be the Principal of Saint Cecilia  
4           Catholic School;

5                       (xiii) Section 9(1) - the allottee of these  
6           funds shall be the President of the College of  
7           Micronesia-FSM;

8                       (xiv) Section 9(3)(b) - the allottee of these  
9           funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;

10                      (xv) Section 9(3)(c) - the allottee of these  
11           funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;

12                      (xvi) Sections 9(3)(d) and 9(11)(w) - the  
13           allottee of these funds shall be the Governor of the  
14           state of Chuuk;

15                      (xvii) Section 9(3)(e) - the allottee of these  
16           funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;

17                      (xviii) Section 9(4)(i) - the allottee of these  
18           funds shall be the Secretary of the Department of  
19           Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure;

20                      (xix) Sections 9(11)(b), 9(11)(n) and  
21           9(11)(v) - the allottee of these funds shall be the  
22           Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of  
23           Micronesia;

24                      (xx) Section 9(11)(d) - the allottee of  
25           these funds shall be the President of the Constitutional

1 Convention;

2 (xxi) Section 9(11)(f) – the allottee of  
3 these funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

4 (xxii) Section 9(11)(g) – the allottee of  
5 these funds shall be the Secretary of the Department of  
6 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure;

7 (xxiii) Section 8(13)(r) the allottee of these  
8 funds shall be the Governor of the State of Yap;

9 (xxiv) Section 9(3)(y) – the allottee of these  
10 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

11 (xxv) Section 9(3)(z) – the allottee of these  
12 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;

13 (xxvi) Section 9(3)(aa) – the allottee of  
14 these funds shall be the Governor of the state of  
15 Kosrae;

16 (xxvii) Section 9(3)(bb) – the allottee of  
17 these funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;

18 (xxviii) Section 9(11)(p) and (s) – the allottee  
19 of these funds shall be the Governor of the State of  
20 Chuuk;

21 (xxix) Section 9(11)(q) – the allottee of these  
22 funds shall be the Governor of the State of Yap;

23 (xxx) Section 9(11)(r) – the allottee of these  
24 funds shall be the Governor of the State of Kosrae;

25 (xxxi) Section 9(3)(t) – the allottee of these

1 funds shall be the President of the FSM Association of  
2 Chamber of Commerce; and

3 (xxxii) Section 9(4)(h) – the allottee of these  
4 funds shall be the Governor of the State of Chuuk

5 (xxxiii) Section 9(4)(j) – the allottee of  
6 these funds shall be the Governor of the State of Yap

7 (xxxiv) Section 9(11)(x) – the allottee of  
8 these funds shall be the Governor of the State of  
9 Chuuk.”

10 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
11 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
12 becoming law without such approval.
