

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 22-157, by amending sections 2, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of fund previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 22-157 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 2 Of the \$2,800,000 appropriated under this act,

14 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-157 is hereby
 15 amended to read as follows:

16 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 17 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 18 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 19 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
 20 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
 21 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
 22 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
 23 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
 24 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
 25 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated

1 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
2 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
3 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be
4 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
5 his designee; EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of funds
6 appropriated under section 3(1) of this act shall be the
7 Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee
8 of funds appropriated under section 3(2) of this act
9 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
10 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
11 subsections 4(1)a, 4(1)(b), 4(1)(c), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b),
12 4(2)(d), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(i) and 4(3)(c) of this act shall
13 be the Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
14 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the
15 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(c)
16 and 4(3)(b) of this act shall be the Secretary of Health
17 and Social Affairs or her designee; the allottee of
18 funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(e) of this act
19 shall be the President of COM-FSM; the allottee of funds
20 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(f) of this act shall
21 be the FSM NOC; the allottee of funds appropriated under
22 subsections 4(1)(d), 4(1)(e), 4(2)(h) of this act shall
23 be the Secretary of the Department of Education or his
24 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
25 subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(d), 4(3)(e), 4(3)(f) and

1 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
2 Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated
3 under subsections 4(3)(h) of this act shall be the
4 Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC); the allottee of funds
5 appropriated under sections 4(3)(j) and 4(3)(n) of this
6 act shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw; the
7 allottee of funds appropriated under sections 4(3)(k)
8 and 4(3)(m) of this act shall be the Vice President of
9 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the
10 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(3)(l) of
11 this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
12 Education or his designee;. The allottee of the funds
13 appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act
14 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee;
15 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
16 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island
17 Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the funds
18 appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act shall be
19 the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee;
20 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
21 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas
22 Development Authority; the allottee of the funds
23 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be
24 the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the
25 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act

1 shall lapse on September 30, 2024.”

2 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
3 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
4 becoming law without such approval.
