PUBLIC LAW NO. 22-180

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$8,820,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$8,820,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
4 September 30, 2023, for the purpose of funding public projects and
5 social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk
6 states. The funds appropriated under this section shall be
7 apportioned as follows:

8 Section 2. Of the \$8,820,000 appropriated under this act,
9 \$1,260,000 shall be apportioned for public projects and social
10 programs for the people of Yap State.

23 Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.
24 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
25 administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws,

1 including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
2 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
3 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
4 the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are
5 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the
6 funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the
7 Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee of funds
8 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the
9 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
10 EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under section 3(1)
11 of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee;
12 the allottee of funds appropriated under section 3(2) of this act
13 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the
14 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b),
15 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(n), 4(2)(p),
16 4(2)(s), 4(2)(t), 4(2)(u) and 4(2)(v) of this act shall be the
17 Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Communications and
18 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated
19 under subsections 4(2)(f), 4(2)(j), 4(2)(k), 4(2)(l), 4(2)(m),
20 4(2)(q) and 4(2)(r) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
21 Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated
22 under subsection 4(2)(i) of this act shall be the Secretary of the
23 Department of Education or her designee; the allottee of funds
24 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(o) of this act shall be the
25 Pohnpei Port Authority (PPA); the allottee of funds appropriated

1 under subsection 4(2)(w) of this act shall be the Mayor of
2 Sapwuahfik Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
3 the funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act
4 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee
5 of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall
6 be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee
7 of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act shall
8 be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee; the
9 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this
10 act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the
11 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this
12 act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of
13 the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall
14 lapse on September 30, 2025.

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1 Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
