

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 22-186, by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 22-186 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 4. Of the \$5,600,000 appropriated under this
4 act, \$1,600,000 shall be apportioned for public projects
5 and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State.

9 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-186 is hereby
10 amended to read as follows:

11 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
12 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
13 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
14 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
15 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
16 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
17 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
18 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
19 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
20 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
21 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
22 State or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated
23 under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President
24 of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
25 EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under

1 section 3(1) of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae
2 State or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated
3 under section 3(2) of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu
4 Town Government or his designee; the allottee of funds
5 appropriated under subsections 4(2)(a), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(f),
6 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(k), 4(2)(q), 4(2)(r), 4(3)(s),
7 4(3)(b), 4(3)(f), 4(3)(j), 4(3)(k), 4(3)(o), 4(3)(p),
8 4(3)(r) and 4(3)(s) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
9 Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds
10 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(i),
11 4(2)(j) 4(3)(a), 4(3)(c), 4(3)(d), 4(3)(i), 4(2)(t),
12 4(3)(d) and 4(3)(q) of this act shall be the Secretary of
13 the Department of Transportation, Communications and
14 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
15 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(b) of this act shall be
16 the President of COM-FSM; the allottee of funds
17 appropriated under subsections 4(2)(m), 4(2)(n), 4(2)(o)
18 and 4(2)(p) of this act shall be the Mayor of Sapuwahfik
19 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
20 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(e), 4(3)(l),
21 4(3)(m) and 4(3)(n) of this act shall be the Meninkeder
22 Laplap; the allottee of funds appropriated under
23 subsection 4(3)(h) of this act shall be the Chief Justice
24 of Kitti Municipal Government, or his designee; the
25 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(l),

1 4(2)(s), and 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
2 Utility Corporation. The allottee of the funds
3 appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act
4 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the
5 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)
6 of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island Development
7 Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the funds appropriated
8 under subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mayor of
9 Weno Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee
10 of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this
11 act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority;
12 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
13 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
14 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
15 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
16 30, 2025.”

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1 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
