

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-86, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-101, 22-102, 22-106, 22-140, 22-147, 22-168, 22-185, 22-197 and 23-06, by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 22-86, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 22-101, 22-102, 22-106, 22-140 and 22-168, is
3 hereby further amended to read as follows:

12 social programs for the people of Chuuk State.

8 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-86, as amended by
9 Public Laws Nos. 22-102, 22-140 and 22-168, is hereby further
10 amended to read as follows:

11 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
12 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
13 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
14 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
15 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
16 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
17 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
18 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
19 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
20 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
21 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
22 State or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated
23 under subsection 3(1) of this act shall be the Governor of
24 the State of Kosrae or his designee; the allottee of funds
25 appropriated under subsection 3(2) of this act shall be

1 the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee. The
2 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this act
3 shall be the President of the Federated States of
4 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of
5 funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(c) of this act
6 shall be the FSM Telecommunication Corporation; the
7 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(g) of
8 this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC);
9 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
10 4(1)(a), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(f),
11 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i), 4(2)(j), 4(2)(l), 4(3)(b), 4(3)(c),
12 4(3)(d), 4(3)(e) 4(3)(f), 4(3)(q) and 4(3)(r) of this act
13 shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the
14 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(j),
15 4(2)(d) and 4(3)(l) of this act shall be the Secretary of
16 the Department of Resources and Development or her
17 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
18 subsections 4(1)(b), 4(1)(d), 4(1)(e), 4(1)(f), 4(1)(h),
19 4(1)(k), 4(1)(l), 4(1)(m), 4(1)(n), 4(2)(g), 4(3)(a),
20 4(3)(g), 4(3)(h), 4(3)(j) 4(3)(k), 4(3)(p), 4(3)(s) ,
21 4(3)(u), 4(3)(z), 4(3)(aa) and 4(3)(ab), of this act shall
22 be the Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
23 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the
24 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(k) of
25 this act shall be the President of the COM-FSM or his

1 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
2 subsections 4(1)(i) 4(3)(o) and 4(3)(i) of this act shall
3 be the Secretary of the Department of Health and Social
4 Affairs or her designee; the allottee of funds
5 appropriated under subsection 4(3)(m) of this act shall be
6 the Vice President of the Federated States of Micronesia
7 or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
8 subsections 4(3)(n), 4(3)(v), 4(3)(w), 4(3)(x), of this
9 act shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw. The
10 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(y) of
11 this act shall be the Luhkenmenlap of Kitti. The allottee
12 of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(t) of this act
13 shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC). The
14 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 5(1),
15 5(2) and 5(7) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk
16 State or his designee; EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds
17 appropriated under subsections 5(1)(a) and 5(1)(b) of this
18 act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his
19 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
20 subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island
21 Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of funds
22 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be
23 the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee;
24 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
25 5(5) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas

1 Development Authority; the allottee of the funds
2 appropriated under subsection 5(6) of this act shall be
3 the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the
4 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall
5 lapse on September 30, 2024.”

6 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
7 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
8 law without such approval.
