

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 15-32, as amended, by amending Section 1 thereof, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein for the State of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 15-32, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 15-36, 15-44 and 15-57, is hereby further amended
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$3,780,000, or so much thereof
5 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
6 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
7 ending September 30, 2008 for the purpose of funding
8 public projects and social programs in each State of the
9 Federated States of Micronesia. The fund shall be
10 apportioned on the basis of \$250,000 or less per member
11 of Congress as follows, PROVIDED THAT an increase of
12 \$300,000 is for Yap State.

2 funding shall deposit the funds into the
3 Special Funds within the General Fund of the
4 Federated States of Micronesia for Chuuk
5 Election District No. 5 established pursuant
6 to Public Law No. 13-83.”

7 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
8 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
9 becoming law without such approval.
