

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 16-49, by amending [~~section 5~~ section 4 and 5], as amended by Public Laws Nos. [~~16-49 and 16-78~~ 16-68 and 16-76], to modify the use of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the State[s] of Chuuk and Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 16-49, as amended
2 by Public Law Nos. 16-68, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 4. Of the sum of \$2,215,000 appropriated by
5 this act, \$610,000 is apportioned for Pohnpei State
6 for public projects and social programs.
