

A RESOLUTION

Expressing the sadness and condolences of the Eighteenth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia at the passing of the Honorable Martin G. Yinug, Chief Justice of the Federated States of Micronesia.

1 WHEREAS, the Honorable Martin G. Yinug, Chief Justice of the
2 Federated States of Micronesia passed away in Yap on August 31,
3 2014; and

4 WHEREAS, the late Martin G. Yinug had a long and illustrious
5 career of public service, including serving as Administrative
6 Assistant with the Yap Delegation for the Congress of Micronesia,
7 Interpreter for the Micronesian Constitutional Convention in 1975,
8 and Directing Attorney for the Yap Branch of the Micronesian Legal
9 Services Corporation; and

10 WHEREAS, the late Martin G. Yinug served as Legislative
11 Counsel to the Yap State Legislature, Floor Leader for the Yap
12 Constitutional Convention, Floor Leader for the Second FSM
13 Constitutional Convention, Associate Justice of the Yap State
14 Court, and Associate Justice of the FSM Supreme Court in 1992; and

15 WHEREAS, the late Martin G. Yinug became the second Chief
16 Justice of the FSM Supreme Court on May 5, 2011, and President of
17 the Pacific Judicial Council in 2014; and

18 WHEREAS, the Members of the Eighteenth Congress of the
19 Federated States of Micronesia join the family, friends and
20 colleagues in mourning the passing of Chief Justice Martin G.

1 Yinug; now, therefore,

2 BE IT RESOLVED that the Eighteenth Congress of the Federated
3 States of Micronesia, Fifth Regular Session, 2014, wishes to
4 express its sadness and condolences to the family, friends and
5 colleagues in mourning the passing of Chief Justice Martin G.
6 Yinug; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
8 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
9 of Micronesia, the Governor of each State of the Nation, and the
10 family of the Honorable Martin G. Yinug.
