AN ACT

To repeal Public Law No. 2-49, to appropriate the sum of \$4,282,216 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia and the sum of \$5,016,831 from the United States Grant Special Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1983, for the operations of the executive branch, legislative branch, National judiciary, Public Auditor, agencies of the National Government, and for special programs, contributions, grants, subsidies, and refunds of the National Government during fiscal year 1983; to establish employment ceilings; and for other purposes.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 percent to and from the funds appropriated to each of the subsections
- 2 in section 1, and may reprogram up to 15 percent to and from the funds
- 3 appropriated in each of the paragraphs within the subsections of section 1.
- 4 (2) The Speaker or his designee may reprogram up to 10 percent
- 5 to and from the funds appropriated to each of the subsections in section 2,
- 6 and may reprogram up to 15 percent to and from the funds appropriated
- 7 in each of the paragraphs within the subsections of section 2.
- 8 (3) The Chief Justice or his designee may reprogram up to 15
- 9 percent to and from the funds appropriated in each of the subsections in
- 10 section 3.
- 11 (4) The Public Auditor may reprogram up to 15 percent to and
- 12 from the funds appropriated in each of the subsections in section 4.
- 13 (5) Allottees of funds may reprogram up to 15 percent to and
- 14 from the funds appropriated in each of the paragraphs within the sub-
- 15 sections of section 5.
- Section 9. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date. All
- 17 funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered,
- 18 and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not
- 19 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979, as amended. The allot-
- 20 tee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof
- 21 as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this
- 22 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appro-
- 23 priated. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated
- 24 by this act except those appropriated by section 6, subsection (11), shall
- 25 lapse as of September 30, 1983. Those funds appropriated by section 6,

1	subsection (11), shall be available for obligation until expended.
2	Section 10. Repealer. Public Law No. 2-49 is hereby repealed.
3	Section 11. Effective date. This act shall become law upon approval
4	by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
5	law without such approval.
