

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-93, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-98, 8-123, 8-137, 9-020 and 9-098, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-98 and 9-098, to modify the use of funds appropriated therein under subsection (1) and to exempt said funds from the lapse provisions of Public Law No. 9-040, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 8-93, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-98 and 9-098, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. The sum of \$1,300,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1995, for school needs throughout the Federated States of Micronesia. The funds appropriated under this act shall be apportioned as follows:

- (1) Chuuk
 - (a) Faichuk
 - (i) Public elementary school needs.....\$ 65,000
 - (ii) PIBC needs..... 5,000
 - (iii) Travel 5,000
 - (iv) School site leases:
 - a) East Wolip Elementary School..... 5,000
 - b) Malaio Elementary School..... 5,000
 - (v) School Projects Coordinator..... 15,000
 - (b) Northern Namoneas
 - (i) Elementary school needs..... 70,000
 - (ii) Junior high school needs..... 10,000
 - (iii) Other school needs..... 20,000
 - (c) Southern Namoneas..... 100,000

(d) Northwest Islands	
(i) Namonweito.....	\$ 75,500
(ii) Other school needs.....	24,500
(e) Mortlocks.....	100,000
(f) Saramen Chuuk Academy	70,000
(g) Chuuk High School Library	30,000
(2) Kosrae	100,000
(3) Pohnpei	
(a) Election District No. 1	
(i) Kolonia Elementary School	33,334
(ii) Other school needs	100,000
(b) Election District No. 2	133,333
(c) Election District No. 3	133,333
(4) Yap	200,000"

Section 2. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds whose use is modified by this act shall be exempt from the lapse provisions of Public Law No. 9-040.

Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
