A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$25,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999, for the purpose of compensating meeting allowances of eligible members of the Educational Task Force on the proposed constitutional amendments which were put forth to the voters during the July 1, 1999 Special Election, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. The sum of \$25,000, or so much thereof as may be  
2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the  
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September  
4 30, 1999, for the purpose of compensating special meeting allowances  
5 of eligible members of the Educational Task Force on the proposed  
6 amendments to the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia  
7 put forth to the voters during the July 1, 1999 Special Election.

8           Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.

9           (1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,  
10 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with  
11 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial  
12 Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds appropriated by  
13 this act shall be the President of the Federated States of  
14 Micronesia or the President's designee. The allottee shall be  
15 responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may  
16 be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act,  
17 and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
18 appropriated.

19           (2) The authority of the allottee to obligate funds  
20 appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1999.


