

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 12-12, as amended, by amending section 13 to change the use of certain funds appropriated for Chuuk State Election District No. ~~3,~~ 2, for Chuuk State Election District No. 3, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 13 of Public Law No. 12-12, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 12-21 and 12-24, is hereby further amended to read  
3 as follows:

4           "Section 13. Capital and Human Resource Development.  
5           The sum of \$11,415,200, or so much thereof as may be  
6           necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
7           of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year  
8           ending September 30, 2002, for capital improvement,  
9           development programs and projects and human resource  
10          development. Of the total funds appropriated under this  
11          section, \$2,955,926 shall be deemed to come from the  
12          capital account funds available under section 211 of the  
13          Compact of Free Association, and \$1,387,700 from the  
14          funds available under section 216(a)(3) of the Compact of  
15          Free Association. The sum appropriated under this  
16          section shall be apportioned as follows:

17                 (1) College of Micronesia-FSM

18                         (a) Operations of the College of

1           Micronesia-FSM, including planning  
2           and construction of new facilities .....\$     3,067,000  
3                   (b) Student assistance for tuition  
4           and housing to be deemed as deriving from

6           Association PROVIDED that these funds shall  
7           be used strictly for direct financial  
8           assistance to COM-FSM students, and PROVIDED  
9           FURTHER that the co-payment by the student or  
10          the student's parent must be proportionally  
11          the same for each in relation to their total  
12          obligation, and PROVIDED FURTHER that only  
13          students maintaining a passing grade point  
14          average will be eligible to receive these  
15          funds. The funds appropriated under this  
16          subsection shall be apportioned as follows:

20                   (c) COM-FSM Multi-purpose gymnasium

 7           those applicants who are selected to receive a  
 8           scholarship and the amount proposed. This  
 9           requirement must be satisfied prior to the  
 10          release of scholarship funds to the students  
 11          selected.

17 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming  
18 law without such approval.
