A RESOLUTION

Calling on the President to encourage Continental Micronesia, Inc., to extend its evening flights from Guam to Pohnpei to include a stop in the State of Kosrae, and to convey to Continental Micronesia, Inc., the request of the Kosrae State Legislature that such service be initiated.

1           WHEREAS, Congress State Communication No. 10-6 transmitted  
2 to the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia Kosrae  
3 State Legislature Resolution Number 6-169, which requested the  
4 National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia to  
5 encourage Continental Micronesia, Inc. to extend its evening  
6 flights from Guam to Pohnpei to include a stop in the State of  
7 Kosrae; and

8           WHEREAS, L.R. No. 6-169 declared that the State of Kosrae  
9 now has a developing tourist industry, that the State of Kosrae  
10 seeks to further develop tourism, particularly for the Japanese  
11 market, and that extending Continental's evening flights to  
12 Kosrae will enhance Kosrae's appeal as a destination for  
13 tourists from Japan, and increase passenger traffic, benefiting  
14 both Continental Micronesia, Inc. and the State of Kosrae; and

15           WHEREAS, the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia  
16 concurs with the sentiments expressed in L.R. 6-169, and desires  
17 to demonstrate its clear support for Kosrae's economic  
18 development goals; now, therefore,


19           BE IT RESOLVED by the Tenth Congress of the Federated  
20 States of Micronesia, Second Regular Session, 1997, that the  
21 Congress hereby calls on the President to encourage Continental  
22 Micronesia, Inc., to extend its evening flights from Guam to  
23 Pohnpei to include a stop in Kosrae, and to direct his cabinet  
24 as appropriate to facilitate any effort Continental Micronesia  
25 makes to so extend its service; and
