A RESOLUTION

Recognizing the contributions of Master Navigator Pius "Mau" Piailug in preserving the ancient art of Micronesian traditional navigation, acknowledging the international good will and recognition generated for Micronesia by his efforts at teaching traditional navigation techniques, and congratulating him on his recognition by the Smithsonian Institute.

- 1 WHEREAS, part of Micronesia's rich cultural heritage are the
- 2 traditional methods of ocean navigation, including the use of stars,
- 3 waves and birds; and
- WHEREAS, in the recent past, modern means of navigation had
- 5 largely displaced traditional navigation methods and interest in
- 6 learning the old ways was waning among our youth and throughout the
- 7 Pacific; and
- 8 WHEREAS, at that time, Pius "Mau" Piailug, of Satawal, Yap,
- 9 traveled to Hawaii and taught our Polynesian cousins the traditional
- 10 Micronesian means of navigation; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the ensuing voyage of the Hokule'a canoe to Tahiti
- 12 ignited new interest in traditional navigation methods throughout
- 13 the Pacific region; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Pius "Mau" Piailug continued to teach the traditional
- 15 ways in Hawaii as well as instructing Micronesian youth in
- 16 traditional navigation techniques; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Pius "Mau" Piailug has opened up the teaching of
- 18 traditional navigation and made it available to all Micronesians who
- 19 desire to learn the old ways; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Pius "Mau" Piailug was recently honored for his work
- 21 by the Smithsonian Institute, which hailed him as "one of the most
- 22 important influences in the resurgence of cultural pride within the
- 23 Pacific"; and
- WHEREAS, Pius "Mau" Piailug's efforts have strengthened our
- 25 ties with our neighbor islands and generated international

- 1 recognition of the great skill of all traditional Micronesian
- 2 navigators; now, therefore,
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED by the Eleventh Congress of the Federated States
- of Micronesia, Third Regular Session, 2000, that the Congress hereby
- 5 acknowledges the contributions that Pius "Mau" Piailug has made in
- 6 preserving and teaching the traditional navigation techniques of the
- Micronesian people; and 7
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Congress congratulates Pius 8
- "Mau" Piailug on his well-justified recognition by the Smithsonian 9
- 10 Institute; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Congress hereby extends its 11
- sincere gratitude to Pius "Mau" Piailug for his tireless efforts at 12
- 13 preserving this part of our cultural heritage, for his contributions
- 14 to good will among the people of the Pacific region, and for the
- recognition and respect that his work has generated for all the 15
- 16 people of Micronesia; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution 17
- 18 be transmitted to the President of the Federated States of
- Micronesia and Master Navigator Pius "Mau" Piailug. 19
