

A RESOLUTION

To approve a technical assistance grant from the U.S. Department of Interior to train, reconcile and conduct an evaluation of the overseas medical referral program and tertiary provider claims in Hawaii.

1 WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Interior approved on April 6,
2 2005 a technical assistance grant request from the FSM Department
3 of Health, Education and Social Affairs in the amount of
4 \$85,015.00 (Project No. FSM-111) to train, reconcile and conduct
5 an evaluation of the overseas medical referral program and
6 tertiary provider claims in Hawaii; and

7 WHEREAS, 55 FSMC 211(2) requires the review and approval by
8 the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia of all first
9 time services and program grants of at least \$50,000 from U.S.
10 federal agencies; now, therefore,

11 BE IT RESOLVED that the technical assistance grant described
12 herein is hereby approved by the Congress of the Federated States
13 of Micronesia;

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as this grant is on a
15 reimbursable basis, the Department of Finance and Administration
16 is hereby encouraged to work with the relevant contractors and the
17 U.S. Department of Interior to minimize as much as possible the
18 gap between the submission of billing documents and grant
19 payments;

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
21 resolution be transmitted to the Secretary of the Department of

1 Health, Education and Social Affairs, the Secretary of Foreign
2 Affairs, and the Secretary of Finance and Administration.
