A RESOLUTION

Respectfully urging the President of the Federated States of Micronesia to nominate a person to fill the position of Secretary of Social Services.

1           WHEREAS, the cabinet-level position of Secretary of Social Services  
2 has been vacant since December of 1982; and

3           WHEREAS, the First Special Session of the Third Congress of the  
4 Federated States of Micronesia, at the request of the President of the  
5 Federated States of Micronesia, considered Congressional Bill No. 3-38,  
6 which would have eliminated the position of Secretary of Social  
7 Services, and failed to pass said bill on First Reading; and

8           WHEREAS, it is the sense of the Fourth Congress of the Federated  
9 States of Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1985, that it is essential  
10 that all vacancies in cabinet-level positions be filled as soon as  
11 possible so as not to unduly disrupt the essential functions of govern-  
12 ment; now, therefore,

13           BE IT RESOLVED by the Fourth Congress of the Federated States of  
14 Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1985, that the President of the  
15 Federated States of Micronesia be hereby respectfully urged to nominate  
16 a person to fill the position of Secretary of Social Services and that  
17 such nomination be transmitted to this Congress as soon as possible; and

18           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution be  
19 transmitted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia and  
20 to the Chief of the Division of Health Services and the Chief of the  
21 Division of Education of the Federated States of Micronesia National  
22 Government.
