16 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia; and

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution  
18 be transmitted to the Honorable Ronald Reagan, President of the  
19 United States of America; Rear Admiral and Mrs. Thomas J. Johnson;  
20 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia; and the Speaker  
21 of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia.


