

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-186, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-189, 23-01, 23-14, 23-47, 23-73 and 23-107, by amending sections 2, 4 and 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
