8 Officer, and Legislative Liaison Officer; and


9 WHEREAS, Mr. Esikiel Malon's long years of public service proved his
10 dedication and devotion to his people; now, therefore,



11 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of

14 Mr. Esikiel Malon; and






