12 WHEREAS, Mr. Harold W. Crouch has brought to the Trust Territory
13 of the Pacific Islands numerous federal programs and has initiated many
14 educational programs for the development of teachers as well as students;

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Harold W. Crouch has been a friend and a counselor
17 to many Micronesians; and


18 WHEREAS, Mr. Harold W. Crouch has resigned from employment with
