A RESOLUTION

Requesting the President of the Federated States of Micronesia and the Governor of the State of Truk to take all action possible to remedy the problems of the Truk State Hospital.

1 WHEREAS, the Truk State Hospital is in dire need of supplies and
2 equipment, including, but not limited to, oxygen, antibiotics, pain-
3 killers, x-ray film, and steam pump and blood pressure equipment; and

4 WHEREAS, failure to have sufficient supplies and equipment
5 inevitably leads to more medical referrals which are approximately
6 ten times more taxing on the health budget than if treated locally; and

7 WHEREAS, unless immediate steps are taken to remedy these most
8 basic problems of the Truk State Hospital the citizens of Truk State
9 will receive less and less health care; and

10 WHEREAS, pursuant to article XIII, section 1, of the FSM
11 Constitution the FSM National Government recognizes the right of the
12 people to health care and is required to take every step reasonable
13 and necessary to provide this service; and

14 WHEREAS, pursuant to article VIII, section 1, of the Truk State
15 Charter the State government is required to provide for the protection
16 and promotion of the public health; and

17 WHEREAS, the existing conditions in the Truk State Hospital leave
18 no doubt that more government steps need to be taken to provide
19 adequately for the public health of Truk State citizens; now, therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of
21 Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 1984, that the Congress hereby
22 requests the President of the Federated States of Micronesia and the
23 Governor of the State of Truk to take all action possible to remedy the
24 problems of the Truk State Hospital; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution
