A RESOLUTION

Requesting an assessment study of the impact of United States Federal programs in health in the Federated States of Micronesia.

1 WHEREAS, the United States has provided funding for health care
2 in the Federated States of Micronesia under many different programs;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, responsibility for health care will be assumed by the
5 State and National Governments under the proposed Compact of Free
6 Association; and

7 WHEREAS, a review and assessment of the impact and effectiveness
8 of United States health programs in Micronesia will provide needed
9 baseline data and insights into effective methods for the delivery
10 of health services in the Federated States of Micronesia; now, therefore,


11 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of
12 Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1983, that the Congress requests an
13 assessment study of the impact of United States Federal programs in
14 health be undertaken in the Federated States of Micronesia as soon as
15 possible; and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution
17 be transmitted to United States Senator Daniel Inouye; the Governors
18 of the States of Kosrae, Ponape, Truk, and Yap; the Chief of the Division
19 of Health Services, Federated States of Micronesia; and the President
20 of the Federated States of Micronesia.
