A RESOLUTION

Supporting the need to establish a medical officer training program in the Federated States of Micronesia.

1 WHEREAS, many of the current medical officers in the Federated
2 States of Micronesia are nearing the age of retirement; and

3 WHEREAS, no training programs are available in the Pacific region
4 to train new medical officers; and

5 WHEREAS, our young and growing population will require medical
6 care in the future; and

7 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii has indicated its interest in
8 helping to establish a medical officers' training program in the Federated
9 States of Micronesia; now, therefore,


10 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of
