A RESOLUTION

Ratifying an "Agreement Concerning Postal Services Between the United States Postal Service and the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia" recently entered into between the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia and the Government of the United States.

1           WHEREAS, the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia and  
2 the Government of the United States entered into a treaty entitled  
3 "Agreement Concerning Postal Services Between the United States Postal  
4 Service and the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia"; and

5           WHEREAS, the purpose of this treaty is to provide for implementation  
6 of Article VI of the Federal Programs and Services Agreement Concluded  
7 Pursuant to Article II of Title Two and Section 232 of the Proposed Compact  
8 of Free Association, prior to the effective date of the Compact; and

9           WHEREAS, it is required by article IX, section 4, of the Constitution  
10 of the Federated States of Micronesia that said treaty be ratified by  
11 the Congress; and

12           WHEREAS, said treaty will benefit the Federated States of Micronesia  
13 by providing international recognition to the Federated States of  
14 Micronesia and by creating the opportunity for the Federated States of  
15 Micronesia to generate significant revenues from the world philatelic  
16 market for postal stamp issues; now, therefore,

17           BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of  
18 Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1983, that the Congress ratifies the  
19 treaty entitled "Agreement Concerning Postal Services Between the  
20 United States Postal Service and the Government of the Federated States of  
21 Micronesia" entered into by the Government of the Federated States of  
22 Micronesia and Government of the United States; and
