A RESOLUTION

Requesting the Office of the Attorney General of the Federated States of Micronesia to assign a well trained and experienced investigator to the State of Yap to investigate major crimes as well as to help the Yap State police investigate other crimes.

1 WHEREAS, the State of Yap is the farthest State from the Capital  
2 of the Federated States of Micronesia; and

3 WHEREAS, the State of Yap is wanting in well trained and  
4 experienced investigators; and

5 WHEREAS, in the past years some major crimes have been committed  
6 with impunity due to this shortage of well trained and  
7 experienced investigators; and

8 WHEREAS, the State of Yap is presently unable to recruit a  
9 well trained and experienced investigator; and

10 WHEREAS, there are relatively well trained and experienced  
11 investigators working for the National Government; and

12 WHEREAS, the State of Yap is enforcing the National Criminal  
13 Code for the Federated States of Micronesia; and

14 WHEREAS, the National Government should assist the State of  
15 Yap and other States in enforcing the National Criminal Code; now,  
16 therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of  
18 Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1983, that the Congress hereby  
19 requests the Office of the Attorney General to assign a well trained  
20 and experienced investigator to the State of Yap to investigate  
21 major crimes as well as to help the Yap State police investigate  
22 other crimes; and


