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A RESOLUTION

Requesting the High Commissioner and the Attorney General of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands to take all steps necessary to guarantee that the owners of lands held under indefinite land use agreements who received compensation for the past use of their parcels up to October 31, 1978, and that the owners of lands held under indefinite land use agreements who received or are waiting to receive compensation for the past use of their parcels up to October 31, 1981, be paid for the use of their lands subsequent to those dates until the termination of the indefinite land use agreements.

1 WHEREAS, in March of 1980 the U.S. Congress appropriated \$4.117
2 million to compensate the owners of indefinite land use parcels for the
3 past use and future use of their lands by the Trust Territory Government;

21 nesia all indefinite land use agreements will terminate automatically
22 in May 1984; and

23 WHEREAS, the Trust Territory Government is responsible for
24 compensating the owners of indefinite land use parcels for the use of
25 their land until the indefinite land use agreements are terminated:

1 now, therefore,
 2 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of
 3 Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1983, that the Congress requests that
 4 the High Commissioner and the Attorney General of the Trust Territory
 5 of the Pacific Islands take all steps necessary to guarantee that the
 6 owners of lands held under indefinite land use agreements who received
 7 compensation for the past use of their parcels up to October 31, 1978,
 8 and that the owners of lands held under indefinite land use agreements
 9 who received or are waiting to receive compensation for the past use
 10 of their parcels up to October 31, 1981, be paid for the use of their
 11 lands subsequent to those dates until the termination of the indefinite
 12 land use agreements; and

 15 Pacific Islands Janet McCoy, Attorney General of the Trust Territory
