A RESOLUTION

Urging the Chief of Micronesian Affairs of the Federated States of Micronesia Department of External Affairs and the Governors of the States of the Federated States of Micronesia to begin planning a nationwide athletic competition.

1 WHEREAS, the recently completed South Pacific Games held in Western
2 Samoa have again demonstrated the unifying benefits of athletic competition
3 among people from different geographical areas and divergent cultural
4 backgrounds; and

5 WHEREAS, the Micro-Olympics, which were held in the Trust Territory
6 of the Pacific Islands, helped to promote greater understanding and
7 friendship among people of distinctive cultures and traditions from the
8 various administrative districts of the Trust Territory; and

9 WHEREAS, it is the sense of the Second Regular Session of the Third
10 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia that athletic competition
11 among representatives and teams from each of the States of the Federated
12 States of Micronesia may well serve to promote and strengthen the feelings
13 of unity on which our Federation is based; now, therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of
15 Micronesia, Second Regular Session, 1983, that the Chief of Micronesian
16 Affairs of the Federated States of Micronesia Department of External
17 Affairs and the Governors of each of the States of the Federated States
18 of Micronesia be hereby encouraged and urged to begin planning for a
19 nationwide athletic competition patterned after the Micro-Olympics; and
