

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140, 19-150, 20-05, 20-15, 20-33, 20-48, 20-63, 20-71, 20-156, 20-175, 21-22, 21-52, 21-146, 21-156, 21-195, 21-213, 21-244, 22-25, 22-62, 22-111, 23-38, 23-55 and 23-62, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund priority infrastructure projects and other programs for Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 19-140, 19-150, 20-05, 20-15, 20-48, 20-175, 21-
3 52, 21-146 and 23-62, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the \$11,300,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$5,650,000 shall be apportioned for priority
6 infrastructure projects and other programs in the state
7 of Chuuk.

8 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by
9 Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140, 20-05, 20-15, 20-33, 20-48,
10 20-63, 20-156, 21-22, 21-146, 21-195, 21-244, 22-111, 23-55 and
11 23-62, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

12 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
13 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
14 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
15 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
16 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
17 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
18 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
19 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
20 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
21 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
22 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of
23 the State of Yap or his designee. The allottee of the
24 funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act
25 shall be the President of the Federated States of

1 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee
2 of funds appropriated under subsections 3(1)(a) and
3 3(1)(b) of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae
4 State or his designee, the allottee of funds
5 appropriated under subsections 4(1)(c), 4(1)(d),
6 4(1)(e), 4(1)(g), 4(1)(h), 4(1)(i), 4(1)(j), 4(1)(k),
7 4(1)(l), 4(1)(m), 4(1)(n), 4(1)(o), 4(2)(f), 4(3)(k),
8 4(3)(q), 4(3)(s), 4(3)(af), 4(4)(b), 4(4)(d) and
9 4(4)(f), shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority
10 (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
11 subsections 4(1)(a), 4(1)(b), 4(1)(f), 4(1)(p),
12 4(1)(q), 4(1)(r), 4(1)(s), 4(1)(t), 4(1)(u), 4(1)(v),
13 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i),
14 4(2)(j), 4(3)(x), and 4(3)(o) shall be the Secretary of
15 the Department of Transportation, Communications and
16 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
17 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(f), 4(3)(i),
18 4(3)(w) and 4(3)(aa) of this act shall be the Luhk en
19 Moanlap of Kitti, the allottee of funds appropriated
20 under subsection 4(3)(ad) of this act shall be the
21 Chief Justice of Madolenihmw or his designee, the
22 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
23 4(3)(ae) of this act shall be the Chief Justice of
24 Kitti or his designee; the allottee of funds
25 appropriated under subsection 4(3)(an) of this act

1 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health and
2 Social Affairs or his designee. The allottee of the
3 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(ak) and
4 4(3)(ao) of this act shall be the Vice President of the
5 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the
6 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
7 4(3)(al) and 4(3)(ap) of this act shall be the
8 Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw Municipal Government
9 or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated
10 under sections 5(2) and 5(7) of this act shall be the
11 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee
12 of funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)(3) of this
13 act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority
14 (MIDA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
15 subsections 5(1)(o), 5(1)(p) 5(1)(1) and 5(1)(4) of
16 this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal
17 Government or his designee; EXCEPT THAT the allottee of
18 funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)(m) of this act
19 shall be the FSM Telecommunication Corporation; the
20 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)(5)
21 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
22 Authority (SNDA); the allottee of funds appropriated
23 under subsection 5(1)(6) of this act shall be the
24 Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the
25 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act

1 shall lapse on September 30, 2026.”

2 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
3 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
4 becoming law without such approval.
